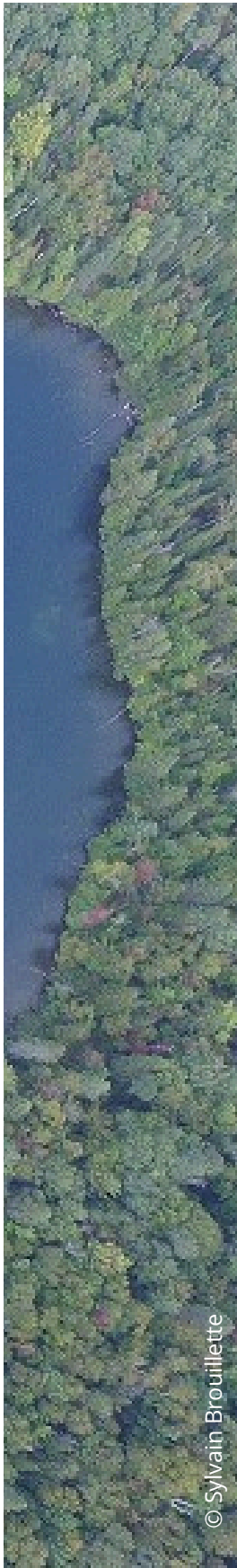

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Visit from parents

Mid-camp Sunday

Parents are invited to visit their children during their stay, on mid-camp Sunday. On this occasion, a musical gathering is scheduled for 11:30 a.m., either in the auditorium or outside. For your comfort, we recommend that you bring beach chairs. In case of rain, or depending on the program, the gathering could also take place in the auditorium. This day is a great opportunity to bring what you need to picnic at Camp musical with your child, or to go off-site for a family activity. Please note that the cafeteria is reserved for staff and campers only. Campers must be back by 4:45 p.m., and parents by that time. Counselors will organize activities for campers whose parents are unable to visit. **Reminder: pets are not allowed.**

Concert

The teachers' concert, held on the 2nd Wednesday of the stay, is another great opportunity for family and friends to visit the campers, depending on the epidemiological situation at the time. Admission: \$15/person (free for the camper).

Departure

Parents and friends are invited to attend the end-of-camp concert at **Saint-Alphonse-Rodriguez church** on the last Saturday of the camp. Please park near the reception desk or cafeteria, then head to the chalet to pick up your luggage, which will already be ready.

Don't forget to:

- Collect ALL luggage
- Check that your child has not forgotten anything (indoor shoes, boots, clothes in the dresser, toiletries in the bathroom).

ITEMS FOUND DURING THE TRIP WILL BE ASSEMBLED IN THE CAFETERIA. BE SURE TO TAKE A LOOK!

Note: Lost items cannot be sent by mail.

Then it's off to the church at **960 Rue Notre Dame, Saint-Alphonse-Rodriguez, QC J0K 1W0** by **10:45 at the latest**. The concert starts at 11 a.m. and finishes around 12:30 p.m. The program will include choral and orchestral tunes, as well as some campers' performances.



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Frequently asked questions

How do you deal with food allergies?

Music Camp offers a nut and peanut-free environment. For other food allergies or intolerances, please indicate this on the registration form. In the event of complex allergies, the Camp reserves the right to ask parents to provide prepared meals to ensure the child's well-being and safety. These will be kept in the cafeteria.

Do you manage the taking of prescription medication?

Yes, the monitors do so as needed, or even the care manager, as the case may be. For more details, please refer to the Medication Distribution and Administration Procedure.

How do I reserve my child's room so he or she can be with friends?

Camp allocates campers to cabins according to age and gender, and tries to accommodate pairing requests on the registration form. Choice of rooms and beds is left to the discretion of campers on a first-come, first-served basis. When you arrive, campers can reserve a room and bed, and set up their personal belongings in it.

What level of learning is required to attend camp?

We welcome young people of all levels. Although a basic knowledge of the instrument is preferable, we occasionally welcome motivated beginners. Lessons are private and young people are not in competition with each other.
