USEFUL INFORMATIONS FOR CAMPERS AND PARENTS

Important: For hygiene reasons and to manage the risk of allergies, campers are not permitted to bring sweets or snacks into the cottages. Meals brought to the camp for campers with serious allergies will be kept in the cafeteria.

ARRIVAL TIMES:

1st session: Sunday, June 28 2020, between 2 and 5 p.m.
2nd session: Sunday, July 12 2020, between 2 and 5 p.m.
3rd session: Sunday, July 26 2020, between 2 and 5 p.m.
4th session: Sunday, August 9 2020, between 2 and 5 p.m.

CLOTHING:

Don't forget to bring a bathing suit, shorts, pants, warm clothes, sneakers, pyjamas, a raincoat, rubber boots, concert clothes, towels, wash cloths and toiletries. Please note that there is no laundry service at the Camp.

BEDDING:

Don't forget to bring a pillow, sheets and blankets **or** a sleeping bag

MUSIC:

Violin, viola, cello, and double bass: instrument, rosin, extra set of strings, nail clippers.

Guitar: instrument, extra set of strings, nail clippers, foot rest.

Percussion: drum sticks.

All instruments: sheet music learned during the year, pencils, metronome

MONEY:

No need at the camp except for the purchase of stamps.

Optional: Cotton (\$ 45), towel (\$ 25), pillowcase (\$ 15) taxes included

OTHERS:

Don't forget to bring a flashlight, solar cream and insect repellent.

ELECTRONICS:

We advise you not to bring expensive electronic devices such as digital cameras, games or communication devices: **in the event of loss or theft, the Camp assumes no responsibility**

VISITING SCHEDULE: Parents can visit their child during the teachers' concert on the Wednesday of the 2nd week and during the Sunday.

On Sunday, parents can attend a campers' choir performance at 11:30 am and picnic in the field. You are invited to a concert given by professional musicians at 5pm. Concert attendance is **MANDATORY** for all campers. The concert program is available a few weeks in advance on the Camp's website. Admission fees are \$ 10 for adults and \$ 5 for students (entry is free for campers).
Departure of the visitors: 18:15.

On the Wednesday of the second week, the concert is given by the teachers and starts at 8 pm: we can meet the campers after the evening meal, starting at 7:15 pm.

DEPARTURE:

The end-of-camp concert (last Saturday of each session) takes place at the church of St-Alphonse-Rodriguez from 11am to 12.30pm. All campers are on stage for the choir, the orchestra participants play the repertoire played during the session and some soloists perform. Further details regarding departure are specified on the document given to all parents upon arrival at the camp

NOTE: The receipt for all fees paid will be given on arrival on Camp.
